The Government of Malawi through the Ministry of Health – Program Implementation Unit (PIU) has been receiving support from The Global Fund and Gavi since 2003 and 2002 respectively. The Ministry of Health (MoH) is the public sector Principal Recipient (PR) of the Global Fund Grant. To effectively administer and manage the grants, the Ministry established a Program Implementation Unit (PIU) to undertake some of the functions of the Principal Recipient in the implementation of the Global Fund Grant
