1. The National Economic Empowerment Fund (NEEF) wishes to inform the general public that it will be disposing of assorted agricultural and solar irrigation equipment through **Sealed Bids**.
2. The items to be disposed of include **fertilizers, seeds, agro-chemicals, solar water pumps, and irrigation pipes**. These items constitute the remaining stock that was previously being disbursed under the Micro Irrigation and Farm Implements Loan Programme. In order to ensure efficient management of public resources and to facilitate the productive utilization of the stored items, NEEF has resolved to dispose of the stock through a transparent and competitive public tender using sealed Bids.

3. The stock is located in various NEEF branches and satellite offices across the country. Members of the public are advised that detailed information regarding item quantities, specific locations, auction dates, and participation requirements are contained in the table below and can be inspected physically in the various NEEF offices at the nearest branch or satellite office as indicated in the table.
4. NEEF therefore encourages interested individuals, farmers, cooperatives, and business entities to contact Procurement Department Unit for inspection and for further information and guidance on the process of disposing of through sealed bids.

8.0 A bidder may bid for either one or multiple lots.

- 9.0 Bidding will be conducted in accordance with disposal procedures contained in the Public Procurement and Disposal of Public Assets Act, 2025 and is open to all eligible bidders.
- 10.0 All bidders shall be required to pay a refundable deposit of K 20,000.00/ Lot when submitting their bids. The deposit is **REFUNDABLE** only when a bidder is not successful and **FORFEITED** when a successful bidder declines to take up one's bid for whatever reasons. Refunds shall be done **ONLY** upon concluding the contract with the winning bidder.
- 11.0 Successful bidders shall be required to pay **100%** of the contract price within **30days** from date of award of contract. Allowable Modes of Payment are **STRICTLY CASH or BANK CERTIFIED CHEQUE.**
- 12.0 In accordance with Section 35 of the Public Procurement and Disposal of Public Assets Act, 2024, all members of staff of National Economic Empowerment Fund and their close relatives shall not be eligible to participate in this disposal proceedings.

- 14.0 Sealed Bids, clearly marked on the outer envelope with "**Description and Reference Number**" must be delivered to the address **17(a)** below. Ensure that prior to depositing your bid you must **register your submission in the bid submission register that shall be placed at the main entrance of the Administration Block at National Economic Empowerment Fund (NEEF) Limited in Lilongwe, then proceed to deposit in the tender box that shall be place right at the front office. The bids must be**

submitted at or before **10:00am (local time)** on **Friday, 13th February, 2026**. Electronic bidding **will NOT** be permitted. **Late bids shall be rejected and returned unopened.**

15.0 Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders or their representatives, who choose to attend at the address **17 (b)** below at **10:00 am (local time) on Friday, 13th February, 2026**
