## Grading, Spot Gravelling and Compacting Kandeu – Chavala road through Mivunza Bridge

 The Ministry of Local Government, Unity and Culture has allocated funding for implementing the Rural Road and water infrastructure Programme in all the councils in Malawi through the Public Sector Investment Programme (PSIP). Therefore, Chikwawa District Council is one of the beneficiaries and is inviting the general public to bid for the Procurement of Grading, spot gravelling and compacting of rural roads as specified below: -

- The Chairperson of the Internal Procurement and Disposal Committee now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders (or eligible for registration) with current NCIC registration in the MK500million or above Civil works Category for the Grading, Spot Gravelling and Compacting Kandeu – Chavala road through Mivunza Bridge.
- 3. Bidding will be conducted in accordance with the open tendering procedures contained in the Public Procurement Law and Regulations of the Government of Malawi and is open to all bidders from eligible source countries. A bidder shall be required to submit a certificate of registration in MK500million or above category as Civil works Contractor registered with the National Construction Industry Council demonstrating registered Contractor status in 2023/24 financial year, as a condition of contract award.
- 4. Bidders are requested to quote for all items in a contract as failure to do so will lead to automatic disqualification for noncompliance.
- 5. A complete set of Bidding Documents in English may be purchased by interested bidder's application to the address at 8 below and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of **Thirty Thousand Kwacha** (**MK30,000**). The method of payment will be **CASH**. The document(s) shall be collected in person, starting from 6<sup>th</sup> September, 2023.
- 6. Bids must be delivered to the address at 8 below on or before 6<sup>th</sup> October 2023, 14:00 hours. All bids must be accompanied by a BID SECURING DECLARATION. Late bids shall be rejected. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend on 6<sup>th</sup> October 2023, 14:00 hours (local time).
