- 1 The World Bank has provided funds to the Government of Malawi under Regional Climate Resilience Program (RCRP) to Rumphi District Council and intends to use part of the funds for procurement of various works within the district.

2. The District Council now invites sealed bids from eligible Bidders who are currently registered in the MK100 Million Kwacha and above Category (Building) and Civil Works with the National Construction Industry Council of Malawi (N.C.I.C).
3. Bidding documents are being purchased from the address below upon payment of a non-refundable fee of MK20, 000.00 from Monday 10th March, 2025. Payment must be in cash or cheque in Malawi Kwacha or any acceptable convertible equivalent currency. Bidding document may be inspected and purchased from:

4. Bid documents shall be deposited into a Tender Box after registration. Late bids will be rejected and returned unopened. Bidders and/or their representatives and members of the general public, may attend the opening of the bids at 14:00hrs local time on Wednesday, 19th March, 2025 in the Council Chamber.
5. It is the responsibility of each Bidder to ensure that bids are submitted in accordance with “Instructions to Bidders” in the bidding documents, as non-compliance to the instructions will lead to disqualification and rejection of the bid. Late bids will be rejected and returned unopened.
6. All Bids must be accompanied by a “Bid-Securing Declaration” and shall be valid for a period of 120 days from the date of bid opening.
7. The District Council does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any bid, but reserves the right to exercise choice of the lowest evaluated substantially responsive bid, in accordance with what it considers to be in its best interest.
