- 1. The Government of Malawi has been receiving support from The Global Fund and Gavi since 2003 and 2002, respectively. The Ministry of Health (MOH) is the public sector Principal Recipient (PR) of the Global Fund Grant and GAVI. In order to effectively administer and manage the grants, the Ministry established a Program Implementation Unit (PIU) to undertake key functions of the PR for the achievement of the underpinning strategic objectives.
- 2. The Ministry of Health has budgeted resources in the Gavi Grant towards the cost of the implementing various interventions and it intends to apply part of the funds towards procurement and payment for provision of Printing Services for data collection tools as one way of improving Data Management and Health care delivery across the Country.
- 3. The Ministry of Health PIU intends to use a portion of the Gavi Grant resources to procure a reputable and suitably qualified Supplier for the Printing services for the following Data Tools:
