- 5. A complete set of Bidding Documents in English may be purchased by interested bidders from the address shown at 7(a) below and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of MK20,000.00. The method of payment shall be Cash.
- 6. Sealed bids, clearly marked on the outer envelope with "Tender Description and Reference Number" must be deposited in the Tender Box at the address in paragraph 7(c) below at or before 10:00 a.m. (local time) on Thursday, 25th September 2025. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend at the address below at paragraph 7(d) on 25th September 2025 at 10.00 hours local time. Electronic bidding will not be permitted and late bids will be rejected and returned to the bidder unopened.
