The Department of e-Government intends to dispose of assorted obsolete and unserviceable assets through public auction.

The assets to be disposed of comprise:

1. ICT Equipment
2. Office Furniture
3. Motor Vehicle Spare Parts

The assets have been identified as obsolete, non-functional, unserviceable, or beyond economical repair.

INSPECTION OF ASSETS

Interested members of the public may inspect the assets at the Department of e-Government, National College of Information Technology (NACIT) Premises, Lilongwe, from 24th August to 28th August 2026 during working hours.

PUBLIC AUCTION

The auction will be conducted as follows:

Venue	Department of e-Government, National College of Information Technology (NACIT) Premises, Lilongwe.

Interested members of the public are invited to attend the auction and participate in the bidding for the assets.

The assets will be sold to the highest bidder, provided that the successful bid meets or exceeds the approved reserve price for the respective asset.

CONDITION OF ASSETS

The assets will be sold on an “as is, where is” basis. Prospective bidders are therefore advised to inspect the assets during the inspection period and satisfy themselves as to their condition before participating in the auction.

By participating in the auction, bidders shall be deemed to have inspected the assets or otherwise satisfied themselves regarding their condition. The Department shall not be responsible for any defects, deficiencies, faults, or other conditions of the assets after the sale.

Successful bidders shall be required to make full payment immediately upon purchase and collect the purchased assets within seven (7) days, at their own cost.
