The bidding document in English Language may be purchased by interested Bidders upon the submission of a written application to the address below and upon payment of a nonrefundable fee of Ten Thousand Malawi Kwacha (MWK10,000.00) or any freely convertible currency. The method of payment will be cash or Bank Certified check.
