PUBLICATION OF PUBLIC PROCUREMENT REGULATIONS 2026 AND DISPOSAL OF PUBLIC ASSETS REGULATIONS 2026

I write to advise you all that in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 97 of the Public Procurement and Disposal of Public Assets Act, 2024, the Minister of Finance, Economic Planning and Decentralization, on the recommendation of the Authority, has made the Public Procurement Regulations 2026, and Disposal of Public Assets Regulations 2026.

In view of the above, the Authority wishes to advise all procuring and disposing entities that effective 24th August 2026, the Public Procurement Regulation 2020 are no longer in use. Instead, you must start using the Public Procurement Regulations 2026 as the subsidiary legislation to the Public Procurement and Disposal of Public Assets Act No 7 of 2025.

In addition, disposal of public assets should be undertaken in compliance with the Disposal of Public Assets Regulations 2026 as the subsidiary legislation to the Public Procurement and Disposal of Public Assets Act No 7 of 2025.

The Authority wishes to advise all Controlling Officers and Heads of procuring and disposing entities that they should make sure that their procuring and disposing entities make use of the new regulations forthwith.

Therefore, I should be grateful if the contents of this Circular are treated with the seriousness they deserve.
